


Hudební Banka is one of the largest music databases where you can find more than 1,5 million high quality tracks of various genres, from classical to current music.



Search


Hudební Banka also allows you to search for similar tracks using **links from Youtube**.

Guide to Creating Reports

To create a report, you need to click on **Reports** in the upper part of the website. You will then see a page where all the reports you create will be located.


There are two ways to report music, you may wish to report only one track, or you may have multiple tracks you would like to report.





Reporting a single track


To report a single piece of music is done by clicking on the create a report icon (in the red circle) located under the icon next to the song you wish to report.



Reporting multiple tracks

There may be two or more pieces of music that need to be reported. The easiest way to report multiple pieces of music is through **Projects**. It's a place where you create folders for the music you would like to use.

Projects can be found on the right-hand side of the web and a new project is created by clicking on the **NEW** icon.



Reporting from projects

To create a report from projects, you will need to click on the icon under the name of the project (in the red circle).

Whether you are reporting just one or multiple pieces of music, the window will pop up where you will need to fill in the information needed to create a report. The information you need to fill in are:

- Name of the report
- Name of the department
- Type of usage (radio, TV or Internet
- Number of usages
- Used duration

After you filled up all necessary information, press **Submit** to create the Report, which will be sent to the email address stated on the report form (below).
